RESOURCE USE AND WASTE

The Project would consume resources and produce waste during its construction.

The Project aims to reduce demand on raw building materials by reusing and recycling materials. The risks associated with the Project's use of resources and production of waste are considered low.

The Project involves the storage and disposal of waste, from general litter to general construction related materials. This carries a contamination risk if the waste is improperly handled.

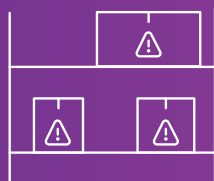
WHAT WE WOULD DO



A Resource and Waste Management Plan (RWMP) will be prepared detailing strategies to apply the waste hierarchy during construction (avoid, minimise, re-use, recycle, dispose) and how to appropriately handle, transport and dispose of waste.



Worksites will be kept tidy, and all general litter would be appropriately disposed of, and recycled where possible.



Hazardous chemicals and other volatile construction waste would be stored safely and managed appropriately.
