

# Phase 1 Consultation Transport Canberra Rapid Bus Network What you told US.

The ACT Government undertook consultation in late 2017 to find out what people think of the public transport network. Canberrans told us they want public transport to be guicker and more frequent. People said they want more services at all times of the day and week.

# Phase 1 Consultation key findings include:



Strong community support: 678 people responded to the survey. 82% use public transport.



Amenities at interchanges are important to commuters, including lighting, shelter and seating.



60% said they were keen to see more flexible bus services for **residents** with limited mobility and

demand responsive services for residents who cannot access regular bus services.



Almost 80% of survey respondents indicated they would be **prepared** to walk further to a bus **Stop** if services were more frequent and journeys faster.



Attractive features of the Rapid Network include frequent services, faster iournevs and access to a broad range of town centres.



Survey responses demonstrate a preference for increased availability of mobile apps and online resources to aid journey planning and receive updates regarding timetabling and route changes.
